Bob Bright was born in Scotland in 1937. He came to Australia in 1961 to play soccer for Gladesville. Started work as a sprinkler fitter with Fire Control in early 1970's, then moved to FFE now Chubb for about 28 years.

Became involved in the Union as a Shop Steward in the early 1980's when the big strike, which lasted 16 weeks, was fought and won by the union. He kept working for FFE until retiring in 1998.

During his time, working in the fire sprinkler industry he made many lifetime friends and well respected as a friend and Union Delegate. He was also the longest serving President of Liverpool RSL. He was laid to rest at Leppington on the 28th March 2008 at one of the largest funerals ever attended there. This was a Testament to the high regard he was held in by his family and friends.
